After the original project plan was approved, the County entered into a Lease Agreement (R2018-0122) with the City of Palm Beach Gardens to construct and maintain the park property. As a result, IST funding is no longer needed for this project. However, \$5M in funding is needed for the planned Riverbend/Loxahatchee River Battlefield Park Interpretive Center located in Jupiter. 

Summary of Transfer Details:

The purpose of this transfer is to increase the construction budget/funding for the "Prairie Rd. over LWDD Lat. 8 Canal" Bridge project. This project will replace an existing bridge (built over 50 years ago) while adding many traffic safety improvements. The project is currently funded within the IST program at \$600,000: \$150,000 for design in FY 2017 and \$450,000 for construction in FY 2019. Design is complete. The project was bid on 3/17/20. The anticipated costs to construct the project now total \$930,000; Construction \$780,000, Contingency \$50,000, and Staff Costs \$100,000. The request is to increase the budget by \$480,000 to cover these anticipated construction costs.

The shortfall in the original funding is due to many reasons including:

- 1) cost estimates for funding were prepared 4-5 years ago, without updates, and construction costs continue to escalate.
- 2) original estimates were based on replacing the existing bridge with a box culvert however, Lake Worth Drainage District (permitting agency) stated that they would not permit a box culvert replacement (requiring the existing bridge be replaced with a new bridge)
- 3) the difficulty in estimating a replacement or rehab of a bridge structure without a prior study or full scope development

In summary, the total funding for the project will be increased by \$480,000 from \$600,000 to \$1,080,000. An additional \$480,000 of funding for the Project is requested through Engineering's IST Reserve account, in FY20
