MISSION

Division of Senior Services (DOSS) mission is to provide accessible and high-quality services to help seniors sixty (60) and older attain optimal independence and promote quality of life for seniors and their caregivers.

GOALS

The goal of the Division of Senior Services is to administer to seniors a comprehensive range of programs that provides social and emotional well being; to encourage independence; and to support seniors and their caregivers within the community with dignity and choice.

DOSS PROGRAMS/SERVICES

DOSS provides information and assistance to aid senior residents age sixty (60) and older and their caregivers. DOSS encourages informed choices that enhance quality of life for seniors.



ADULT DAY CARE

Adult Day Care emphasizes social and recreational activities in a group setting, with some health monitoring. Clients attending Adult Day Care usually do not need medical attention during the day, but may need supervision for safety and activities of daily living.

Adult Day Care Programs provide a structured program of therapeutic, rehabilitative, social and leisure activities in a monitored setting. The programs offer supportive services to the participant, as well as to the family, by providing care and supervision in a protective environment during the day. Participants attend the program on a scheduled basis and services may include the following:

Counseling	Supervision

Recreation	Transportation
Respite Care	Health Screening
Socialization	Education
