3	All	FDOT Item numbers are for use in determining eligibility for price adjustment per General Provision 9-2 only.
4	All	Excavation and backfill for structures including cost of any select bedding material that may be necessary for satisfactory installation as directed by palm beach county is considered incidental to the cost of the structures.
