At the end of the presentations Simmons & White, HBC Engineering Company, and Stanley Consultants observed the discussions.

Committee discussed each presentation and the project and then voted.

Voting resulted in a tie for second place and as two firms were to be selected, second place is an awardable position and therefore per PPM CW-O-048 (Section VII.A.5) the tie breaking procedure was utilized.

### Tie Breaking Levels:

- 1. Team with most first place votes
- 2. Team with greater SBE percentage
- 3. Team with lowest volume of previous work

The first level tie breaker resulted in HBC Engineering Company having two (2) first place votes and Stanley Consultants, Inc. having one (1) first place vote. Therefore, the tie was broken in HBC Engineering Company's favor and they were designated as the second place ranked firm.
