The order of business was to select two consultants.

Each consultant made a presentation of their qualifications before the Final Selection Committee and answered questions from committee members.

At the end of the presentations Steven Carrier, P.E., Assistant County Engineer stated that the public is welcome to make comments or sit and observe the discussions. All teams were present.

Committee discussed each presentation and the project and then voted.

Voting resulted in a tie for second place and therefore per PPM CW-O-048 (Section VII.A.5) the tie breaking procedure was utilized.

#### Tie Breaking Levels:

- 1. Team with most first place votes
- 2. Team with greater SBE percentage
- 3. Team with lowest volume of previous work

The first level tie breaker resulted in BCC Engineering, LLC placing third. Therefore, the tie was broken in CHA Consulting, Inc.'s favor and they were designated as the second place ranked firm.
