


PEDESTRIAN FLASHERS ON CR-A1A


FROM NORTH OF DONALD ROSS ROAD TO SOUTH OF INDIANTOWN ROAD

PROJECT:

Palm Beach County will be securing Federal funding to construct solar powered, pedestrian activated flashers at 24 existing pedestrian crossings on County Road A1A from north of Donald Ross Road to south of Indiantown Road.

- The existing crossings are either midblock or at intersections without any traffic control that would require vehicular traffic to stop.
- The flashers will be installed within the existing County right-of-way.
- Ramps and crosswalk striping will also be upgraded to the current Federal and State standards.
- This project will enhance the safety of pedestrians utilizing the corridor to access the beach.





SCHEDULE:

Design will be completed by Fall 2021 and construction is scheduled to begin in 2022.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACT:

- To minimize impact on residents and on the sea turtles, construction is limited to daytime and weekday work.
- During construction, at least one lane of traffic will be maintained at all times.
- Continued access will be provided to business and residents in the project area.
