Vendors Licenses

What Are The Differences In Vendors Licenses?

A <u>roadside vendor</u> Is located within the County right-of-way and may sell only produce, plants, flowers or prepared food. Applicants must obtain a permit from the Department of Engineering (561-684-4030), a license from PBC Tax Collector (561-355-2272) and the Division of Hotel & Restaurants (850-487-1395) if selling prepared food.

A <u>mobile vendor</u> Is located on private property with the permission of the property owner, may sell a variety of items, and requires a Special Permit from the Zoning Division (561-233-5200), a license from PBC Tax Collector (561-355-2272), and the Division of Hotel & Restaurants (850-487-1395) if selling prepared food.

A <u>transient vendor</u> travels from place to place selling ice cream or a variety of items, stopping periodically. The applicant must be approved by the Zoning Division (561-233-5200) and possess a license for his office location from PBC Tax Collector (561-355-2272), and Hotels & Restaurants (850-487-1395) (if food).

<u>Door to door sales</u> requires approval by the Zoning Division (561-233-5200) and a PBC license if office is located in PBC. Goes directly to the PBC Tax Collector's office if his office is located outside of PBC.

A <u>park location</u> Any vendors going into a park, must be approved by the PBC Parks Department (561-966-6600).

IF YOU LIVE IN A MUNICIPALITY, CALL THAT CITY TO GET BUSINESS LICENSE, EVEN TO VEND IN UNICORPORATED PBC. TO VEND IN A CITY, CALL THAT CITY.
