What Is NENA?

- The Northeast Everglades Natural Area (NENA) is a collection of conservation lands (165,000 acres) as well as activity and education centers lying in northern Palm Beach County and southern Martin County.
- NENA provides residents and visitors with a wide range of nature-based outdoor recreational opportunities.

Jesup Trail

- 6-mile multiuse trail.
- Backcountry multiuser access from Cypress Creek Natural Area in Palm Beach County to Jonathan Dickinson State Park in Martin County.

Project Benefits

- Provides a unique alternate transportation route between Palm Beach and Martin Counties.
- Offers views of rare hardwood plant communities and black water creeks that feed the Loxahatchee River.

Project Overview

- Approximately 6 miles of hardened, improved trail will extend from Cypress Creek Natural Area through Cypress Creek Management Area to a multi-user entrance into Jonathan Dickinson State Park.
- The trail will accommodate shared-use access for hiking, bicycling, and equestrian activities.
- Trail amenities will include:
 - Chickee shade shelter
 - Horse hitches and bike racks at trailheads in Cypress Creek Natural Area
 - Informational kiosks/signs
- Project planning is underway.
- Currently the unimproved trail is not open to the public.
