following chart and descriptions as a guide for preferred camera angles, lighting conditions, and background.

- 1) Take the photos with a high-resolution digital camera (a minimum of 3 mega pixels is recommended).
- Take the photo in an area that is well lighted, but not in a glare, and position yourself so that the sun or artificial light source does not cast your shadow into the picture.
- 3) Make sure the vehicle is washed and all logo decals have been removed with automotive adhesive remover (3M or similar). If primer must be used, select a primer color that closely matches the vehicle. If possible, pressure wash off-road equipment to remove grease and caked mud caught in treads, tracks and body panels. Make sure that truck beds are free of accumulated trash.
- 4) Select an area with a neutral background; avoid clutter showing up behind the vehicle. Shrubbery generally makes a good backdrop.
- 5) The preferred camera locations for common vehicles are the right or left front corners of the vehicle, at approximately a 40 degree angle from straight-on, standing 8-10 feet back from the vehicle, and holding the camera at just above rooftop level (except for very tall equipment). By pointing the camera about one-third of the distance down the right or left side of the vehicle, the entire vehicle should be in the photo frame. Under these conditions, the vehicle will be well displayed and you will avoid "fish-eye" distortions of shooting directly at the leading edge (the front edge of the front fender).
