Mr. Volton Williams, Interim Director of Administrative Services, better known in the transit industry by his middle name, Michael joined Palm Tran's management team as Fiscal Manager on May 2, 2016. As a member of Palm Tran's Executive Management Leadership team, Mr. Williams is responsible for leading and directing Palm Tran's Administrative Services Division which includes human resources, organization development, finance and budgeting, procurement and material inventory.

Mr. Williams has over 19 years of senior management experience in budgeting, financial planning and programming, grants management and compliance, procurement, auditing and legislative and government affairs at the state and federal levels and regional transit planning.

Prior to joining Palm Tran, Mr. Williams served as Capital Budget Manager for the Tri-County Commuter Rail Authority (Tri-Rail) where he developed and managed the agency capital improvement program and provide financial management and policy guidance as well as federal and state programming for transit projects. Mr. Williams then served as Director of Planning and Capital Development for the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) formerly the Tri-Rail where he oversaw short and long range operational and financial planning, grants program and funding, legislative and government affairs activities, real estate acquisition and development and budgeting. He was instrumental in the successful development and implementation of the Tri-Rail Double Track Corridor Improvement Program and the creation of the SFRTA.

Mr. Williams went on to join Provo Stevedoring Limited, a subsidiary of Herzog Contracting Corporation, as Director of Finance and Administration and later served as Deputy Manager for Herzog Caribbean overseeing government infrastructure projects throughout the Caribbean. He then decided to get back into transit and joined SunLine Transit Agency in Palm Springs, California where he served as their Chief Administrative Officer responsible for Human Resources, Labor Management, Systemwide Planning, Grants Administration, Marketing and Customer Service.
