LOCATION: R. G. Kreuzler Park, 2882 S. Ocean Blvd., Palm Beach, FL 33480

COURSE: One-mile ocean swim. Exact course layout will be based on safety and determined by race day conditions. Hand Timing.

AWARDS: Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place: male and female overall. Medals will be awarded to 1st -3rd places in the following age divisions: male and female 14 & under, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, and 70 & over. Awards presentation and refreshments immediately following swim.
