

ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 008

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING THE 1989 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 89-17, AS AMENDED; AMENDING THE FUTURE LAND USE ATLAS (FLUA); ADOPTING SMALL SCALE AMENDMENT **ATLANTIC/SIMS MEDICAL OFFICE (SCA 2009-002)**; MODIFYING PAGE **99** BY CHANGING A **1.70** ACRES PARCEL OF LAND LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF SIMS ROAD, 0.25 MILE NORTH OF ATLANTIC AVENUE, FROM HIGH RESIDENTIAL, 8 UNITS PER ACRE (HR-8) TO INSTITUTIONAL (INST); PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 1989 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on August 31, 1989, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners adopted the 1989 Comprehensive Plan by Ordinance No. 89-17; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners amends the 1989 Comprehensive Plan as provided by Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Section 163.3187(1)(c), Florida Statutes, provides comprehensive plan amendments directly related to small scale development activity may be made by local governments without regard to statutory limits regarding the timing and frequency of plan amendments; and

WHEREAS, Section 163.3187(1)(c)4, Florida Statutes, provides that small scale development amendments require only one public hearing before the governing board which shall be an adoption public hearing; and

WHEREAS, a property owner has initiated an amendment to the Future Land Use Atlas of the 1989 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment meets the criteria of a small scale development amendment per Section 163.3187(1)(c), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Local Planning Agency conducted a public hearing on January 16, 2009, to review the proposed amendment to the Palm Beach County Comprehensive Plan and made recommendations regarding the proposed amendment to the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners, as

1 the governing body of Palm Beach County, conducted a public hearing
2 pursuant to Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes, on April 23, 2009,
3 to review the recommendations of the Local Planning Agency and to
4 consider adoption of the amendments; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners has
6 determined that the amendment complies with all requirements of the
7 Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land Development
8 Regulation Act.

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY**
10 **COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:**

11 **Part I. Amendments to the Future Land Use Atlas of the Land Use**
12 **Element of the 1989 Comprehensive Plan**

13 The following amendment to the Future Land Use Element's Future
14 Land Use Atlas is hereby adopted and is attached to this Ordinance:

15 **A. Future Land Use Atlas page 99** is amended as follows:

16 **Application No.:** Atlantic/Sims Medical Office

17 (SCA 2009-002)

18 **Amendment:** High Residential, 8 units per acre (HR-8)
19 to Institutional (INST);

20 **General Location:** West side of Sims Road, 0.25 mile north of
21 Atlantic Avenue;

22 **Size:** Approximately 1.70 acres;

23 **Conditions:** None

24 **Part II. Repeal of Laws in Conflict**

25 All local laws and ordinances applying to the unincorporated area
26 of Palm Beach County in conflict with any provision of this ordinance
27 are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

28 **Part III. Severability**

29 If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of
30 this Ordinance is for any reason held by the Court to be
31 unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding shall not affect
32 the remainder of this Ordinance.

33 **Part IV. Inclusion in the 1989 Comprehensive Plan**

34 The provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part
35 of the 1989 Palm Beach County Comprehensive Plan. The Sections of the
36 Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such, and the

word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or any other appropriate word.

Part V. Effective Date

This amendment shall not become effective until 31 days after adoption. If challenged within 30 days after adoption, this amendment shall not become effective until the state land planning agency or the Administration Commission, respectively, issues a final order determining the amendment is in compliance.

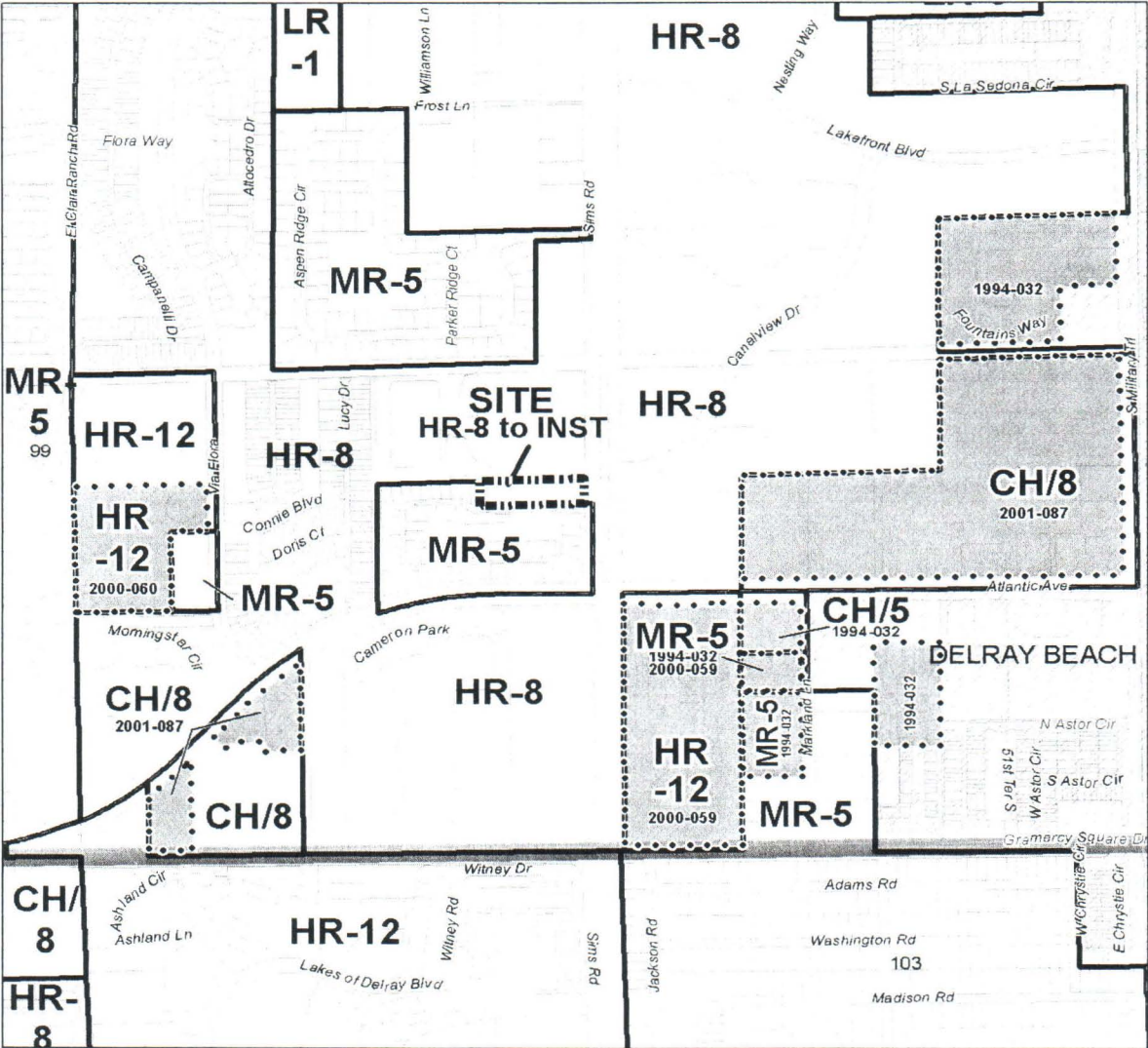
