ZONING RESOLUTION NO. R-71-460

MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

ADOPTED November 18, 1971

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 18th day of November 1971, adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3-57, pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959, and Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

- * The Southwest 1/4 of Section 23, the South 1/2 of Section 22, and the Northwest 1/4 of Section 22, all in Township 46 South, Range 42 East, less the South 700 feet of the North 766 feet of the West 900 feet of the East 950 feet of said Northwest 1/4 of Section 22 is hereby rezoned from A-1 Agricultural District to R-2A Multiple Family Dwelling District.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Culpepper, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lytal, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
