

RESOLUTION NO. R-73- 388

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-76 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 June 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of June, 1973, that petition No. 73-76, the petition of ST. JAMES AME METHODIST CHURCH by Donald L. Kiselewski, Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A CHURCH on the North 1/2 of Lot 34 and all of Lots 35 and 36, Cinquez Park, Second Addition, in Section 3, Township 41 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 21, page 20. Said property located on the east side of Carver Avenue and 450 feet north of Indiantown Road in an RH-Residential Multiple Family District (High Density), was approved as advertised.
