

RESOLUTION NO. R-73-395

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-66 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 June 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of June, 1973, that petition No. 73-66, the petition of ORIOLE HOMES CORPORATION by E.E. Hubshman, President, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT on a portion of Sections 15 and 16, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, being more particularly described as follows': commence at the Southwest corner of the Southeast 1/4 of said Section 16; thence run North 1° 15' 47" East, on an assumed bearing, along the West line of said Southwest 1/4 of said Section 16, for 85.88 feet to a point lying 7.00 feet Northerly of as measured at right angles to the North right-of-way line of State Road No. 806, as said State Road is recorded in Road Plat Book 3, page 24; thence run South 89° 40' 59" East along said line being 7.00 feet North of the North right-of-way line of said State Road, for 60.01 feet to a line being 60.00 feet East of as measured at right angles to the West line of said Southeast 1/4 of said Section 16; thence run North 1° 15' 47" East along said line

being 60.00 feet East of and parallel to said West line of the Southeast 1/4 of said Section 16, for 990.23 feet to the Point of Beginning of the herein described parcel; thence continue North 1° 15' 47" East along said parallel line for 2374.39 feet; thence run South 89° 47' 04" East for 1268.40 feet; thence run North 1° 07' 35" East for 688.00 feet; thence run South 89° 44' 24" East for 1327.94 feet; thence run South 89° 29' 04" East for 2747.15 feet; thence run South 0° 53' 00" West for 4021.05 feet to a Point of Curvature to a curve concave to the Northeast having a radius of 25.00 feet and a central angle of 90° 34' 35"; thence Southeasterly along the arc for 39.52 feet to a point of cusp., said point lying on a line 7.00 feet North of and parallel to the North right-of-way line of the aforementioned State Road No. 806; thence run North 89° 41' 35" West along said parallel line for 85.26 feet; thence North 89° 40' 59" West continuing along said parallel line for 3988.74 feet; thence run North 1° 15' 47" East for 990.23 feet; thence run North 89° 40' 59" West for 1320.00 feet to the Point of Beginning. Said property located east of Hagen Ranch Road and the north side of Delray West Road (S.R. 806) in an RH-Residential Multiple Family District (High Density), was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Required turning lanes shall be constructed by the developer prior to issuance of building permits;
- (2) The developer shall ins-tall traffic lights at no cost to the County and prior to filing succeeding plats, when there is a necessity, as determined by the County Engineer, for signalization of the project entrance road and Jog Road intersection with Delray West Road.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Culpepper , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Warren , and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


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The Chairman thereupon declared the resolution duly passed and adopted this 17th day of July, 1973.
