

RESOLUTION NO. R-73- 435

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION'

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-127 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 July 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 26th day of July, 1973, that petition No. 73-127, the petition of BURNUP AND SIMS, INC., by S. Perry Keziah, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT, of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 and that part of the South 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 lying South of the railroad right-of-way of Section 24, Township 43 South, Range 42 East. Said property located approximately .2 mile north of Okeechobee Boulevard (S.R. 704) and approximately .4 mile east of Military Trail (S.R. 809), was approved as advertised.
