

RESOLUTION NO. R-73- 447

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION'

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-97 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 July 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 26th day of July, 1973, that petition No. 73-97, the petition of EVERETT FRYE AND W.G. LASSITER, JR., for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT on the South 1/2 of the Mortheast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 14, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, less the right-of-way of State Road 809 (Military Trail) as shown in Road Plat Book 3, page 183 AND THE FURTHER SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A SHOPPING CENTER on the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 14, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, less the North 190 feet of the East 190 feet thereof, less the right-of-way of State Road 8.09 (Military Trail) as shown in Road Plat Book 3, page 183, less the right-of-way of State Road 806 (Delray West Road)

as shown in Road Plat Book 3, page 24. Said property located on the west side of Military Trail (S.R. 809) and on the south side of Delray West Road (S.R. 806), was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Prior to the issuance of any building permits, the developer shall dedicate, to Palm Beach County, the additional right-of-way required to provide for a one hundred twenty (120) foot right-of-way for Del-ray West Road (S.R. 806) and Military Trail (S.R. 809).

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Weaver, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Warren, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
