

RESOLUTION NO. R-73-572

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-136 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 23 August 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 23rd day of August, 1973, that petition No. 73-136, the petition of RIVIERA BROADCASTING CORPORATION by Alan Kornish, President, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW FOUR (4) RADIO TOWERS, EACH BEING THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE (385) FEET IN HEIGHT, on the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4, less the North 25 feet and the South 25 feet thereof for road purposes, Section 1, Township 43 South, Range 42 East. Said property located approximately 600 feet east of Military Trail (S.R. 809) between Upthegrove Lane and Wright Road in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Culpepper, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Warren, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


