

RESOLUTION NO. R-73- 573

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-139 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 23 August 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 23rd day of August, 1973, that petition No. 73-139, the petition of MEL ELECTRIC, INC., by John C. Mills, President, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 1, Township 46 South, Range 42 East; less the North 495 feet and the East 159.83 feet as measured at right angles and less rights-of-way for Military Trail and Coconut Road. Said property located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Military Trail (S.R. 809) and Coconut Road, was denied as advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Warren, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Gulpepper, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
