

RESOLUTION NO. R-73-613

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-67 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 27 September 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 27th day of September, 1973, that petition No. 73-67, the petition of LORRAINE CIUCI for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A KENNEL FOR DOMESTIC ANIMALS on Tract 9, Block 34, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, in Section 31, Township 44 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 48. Said property located at the northeast corner of State Road No. 7 and Woodwind Lane in an AG-Agricultural District, was denied as advertised.
