

RESOLUTION NO. R-73-633

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-175 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 September 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of September, 1973, that petition No. 73-175, the petition of THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA by Lake Lytal, Chairman, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO PO-PUBLIC OWNERSHIP DISTRICT of the North 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 12, Township 41 South, Range 41 East. Said property located on the west side of State Road No. 7 approximately .3 mile south of Randolph Siding Road, was approved as advertised.
