

RESOLUTION NO. R-73-705

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-187 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 October 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of October, 1973, that petition No. 73-187, the petition of STANLEY AND GEORGIA M. WISEMAN for the REZONING, FROM RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of Lot 3, less road right-of-way, Pleasant Valley in Section 5, Township 44 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 21, page 54. Said property located on the east side of Fla-Mango Road approximately .3 mile north of Summit Boulevard, was denied as advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Johnson, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Culpepper, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
