

RESOLUTION NO. R-73- 723

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION .

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-207 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 October 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of October, 1973, that petition No. 73-207, the petition of THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY by Lake Lytal, Chairman, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRI-CULTURAL DISTRICT TO PO-PUBLIC OWNERSHIP DISTRICT of Tracts 23, 24, 49 and 50, Block 80, less the right-of-way for Florida's Turnpike, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3 in Section 29, Township 47 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 53. Said property located on the west side of Florida's Turnpike and on the north side of L.W.D.D. Lateral Canal No. 49, was approved as advertised.
