

RESOLUTION NO. R-74- 1004

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING .PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-171 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 21 November 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 21 day of November, 1974, that petition No. 74-171, the petition of HERBERT W. BIGGS, TRUSTEE, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT of Tract 37 and the West 1/2 of Tract 38, Block 22, less the following described parcel: the South 295 feet of the West 1/2 of Tract 38, together with the South 295 feet of the East 56.37 feet of Tract 37, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3 in Section 22, Township 44 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, .. pages 45 through 54. Said property located on the north side of Chicesaw Road approximately 900 feet west of Jog Road, was approved as advertised.




