

RESOLUTION NO. R-75- 159

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-26 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 27 February 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 27th day of February, 1975, that petition No. 75-26, the petition of BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA by E. W. Weaver, Chairman for the REZONING, FROM RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of all of Block 63, North Palm Beach Heights Unrecorded Subdivision in Section 22, Township 41 South, Range 42 East, as shown on Tax Assessors Map No. AM-45. Said property located approximately one (1) mile north of Donald Ross Road and approximately 1/2 mile east of Florida's Turnpike, was approved as advertised.
