## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

Said property located on the south side of Dolphin Drive approximately 900 feet west of Military Trail (S.R. 809) in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised, subject to the following special condition:

The maximum allowable number of children shall be twenty (20), until such time that a larger septic tank facility is installed to accommodate an increase in the number of children.
