

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-413

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-61 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29 May 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 29 day of May, 1975, that petition No. 75-61, the petition of BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, by E.W. "Bud" Weaver, Chairman, for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO PO-PUBLIC OWNERSHIP DISTRICT of Lots 152 and 191, Tropical Terrace, in Section 10, Township 45 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 22, page 58. Said property located on the north side of Miner Road approximately 350 feet west of U.S. No. 1, was approved as advertised.
