

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-607

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-103 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 August 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of August, 1975, that petition No. 75-103, the petition of MARGARET D. KENNEDY for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A DAY CARE CENTER on Tract 21, Haverhill Acres, in Section 26, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 20, page 75. Said property located at the southwest corner of South Stacy Road approximately .3 mile west of Haverhill Road in an RH-Residential Multiple Family District (High Density), was approved as advertised.

Commissioner Johnson, moved for approval of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lytal, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


