

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-611

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 764110 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 August 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of August, 1975, that petition No. 75-110, the petition of BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, by E.W. "Bud" Weaver, Chairman, for the REZONING, FROM RH-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (HIGH DENSITY) TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, of Lots 1 through 7 inclusive, Block 1, Delray Shores in Section 7, Township 46 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 24, pages 232 and 233. Said property located on the south side of Lake Ida Road approximately .1 mile east of Davis Road, was denied as advertised.
