

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-958

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-142 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 18 December 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 18th day of December, 1975, that petition No. 75-142, the petition of BLASIUS AND NADINE D. KAMMERER by Shepard Lesser, Attorney, for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of Lots 1 and 2, Block 1, Congress Park in Section 5, Township 44 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 23, page 140. Said property located on the east side of Congress Avenue approximately 600 feet south of Summit Boulevard, was approved as amended to include a Special Exception for a Planned Commercial Development, subject to a variance approval from the Board of Adjustment.
