

RESOLUTION NO. R-77- 136

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-1 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 27 January 1977.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 27th day of January, 1977, that petition No. 77-1 the petition of JAMES BRADLEY GARRIS for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT, of the West 1/2 of the East 1/2 of Tract 5, Block 5, Palm Beach Farms Company, Plat No. 3, in Section 34, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 46, less the North 25 feet thereof. Said property located on the south side of Belvedere Road, approximately 1.6 miles west of Haverhill Road, was approved as advertised.

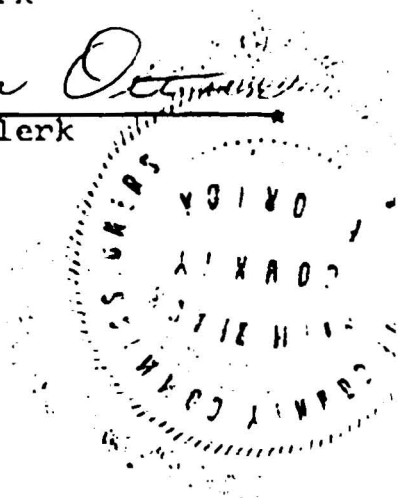
