RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

LIBERTI, Executive Director of Planning, Zoning and Building Department for the REZONING, FROM RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT TO AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT of all of Section 35, Township 44 South, Range 41 East; Lots 1 to 8 inclusive, Tract 38, Hiatus between Townships 44 and 45 South, Range 41 East; Section 2, less the East 3/4 of the Southeast 1/4, Township 45 South Range 41 East, Palm Beach County, Florida. Said property located approximately 1 mile west of State Road No. 7, and approximately 3/4 mile South of Lake Worth Road Extension, was approved as advertised.
