No. 77 – 96 Katula, Jr., President, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A WATER BOOSTER PUMPING STATION on a parcel of land in the Northwest 1/4 of Section 26, Township 43 South, Range 42 East being more particularly described as follows: commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northwest 1/4 of said Section 26; thence run West a distance of 168 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence run West a distance of 50 feet to a point; thence run North 0° 33' 40" East a distance of 67.00 feet to a point; thence run East a distance of 50 feet to a point; thence run South 0° 33' 40" West a distance of 67.00 feet to the Point of Beginning. Said property located 1/2 mile south of Okeechobee Boulevard at the south end of East Breezy Lane in an RM-Residential Multiple Family District (Medium Density), was approved as advertised subject to the following special conditions:

 Upon completion of construction, the Developer shall restore the site to its original contours.
