

RESOLUTION NO. R-78-1130

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-185 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 24 August 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 24th day of August, 1978, that petition No. 78-185 the petition of GILBERT T. HOARD for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT of Tract 69, Plat of Jupiter Farms and Groves, in Section 1, Township 41 South, Range 41 East, as recorded in Plat Book 9, page 76. Said property located on the north side of Randolph Siding Road, approximately .7 mile south of Indiantown Road (S.R. 706), was approved as advertised.
