

RESOLUTION NO. R-79-179

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Eoard of County Commissioners , as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes', is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No, 79-3 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 January 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 25th day of January, 1979 , that petition No. 79-3 the petition of BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, by Peggy Evatt, Chairman, for the FEZONING, FROM RH-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (HIGH DENSITY) TO PO-PUBLIC OWNERSHIP DISTRICT of that part of the South 800 feet of the West 1/4 of the Mortheast 1/4 of Section 3, Township 41 South, Range 42 East, lying north of S.R. 706. Said property located on the north side of Indiantown Road (S.R. 706), approximately 1.3 miles west of North Pennock Lane and 300 feet south of Lateral Canal C-18, was approved as advertised.

Commissioner Gregory , moved for approval of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Evatt , and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:




