

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 79-16 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 January 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 25th day of January, 1979, that petition No. 79-16 the petition of BOCA GLADES, INC., by John R. Van Norman, Jr., Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT AND THE FURTHER SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PLANNED OFFICE-BUSINESS PARK, INCLUDING A FUNERAL HOME on a portion of Block 77, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, in Section 18, Township 47 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, pages 45-54, being more particularly described as follows: Tracts 93 and 94, less the North 290.39 feet of Tracts 93 and 94, and less the South 40.0 feet of Tracts 93 and 94, and less the East 60.0 feet of Tract 94. Said property located on the north side of Boca Raton West Road (S.R. 808), approximately .7 mile east of S.R. 7, was denied as advertised.
