RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 79-124 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 June 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 28th day of June, 1979, that petition No. 79-124 the petition of JIMMIE and JEANETTE DANIELS, by Peggy Whitaker, Realtor Associate, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT of Tract 15, Block 11, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, in Section 5, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 46, except the South 18 feet thereof taken for road purposes. Said property located on the north side of Pioneer Road, approximately 680 feet west of Benoist Road (80th Avenue South), was approved as advertised.
