RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 23rd day of June, 1980 , that Petition No. 80-109 the petition of EDWARD FARIAS, by David A. Hall, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RT-RESIDE? TRANSITIONAL DISTRICT of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 o the Southeast 1/4 of Section 26, Township 44 South, Range 42 East; less a strip of land 40 feet in width and running parallel with and contiguous to the North line of said parcel; also less a strip of land 45 feet in width running parallel with and contiguous to the West line of said parcel. Said property located on the south side of Melaleuca Lane, approximately . 8 mile west of Military Trail (S.R. 809), was approved as advertised.
