

RESOLUTION NO. R-81-1051

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 81-117 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 23 July 1981; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. The proposal would be in harmony and compatible with the present and future development of the area concerned

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this **23** day of **July** **1981**, that Petition No. 81-117 the petition of CARL CALLOWAY for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, IN PART, AND RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY), IN PART, TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT on the **South** 233 feet of the East 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 25, Township 44 South, Range 42 East;

less the South 90 feet of East 283 feet of East 1/4 of Southeast 1/4 of Northwest 1/4 of Section 25, Township 44 South, Range 42 East; less the South 195 feet of West 50 feet of East 1/4 of Southeast 1/4 of Northwest 1/4 of Section 25, Township 44 South, Range 42 East. Said property located on the west side of Military Trail (S.R. 809), approximately 200 feet south of Pine Forest Drive, was approved as advertised.
