of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 2, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, together with an easement for ingress and egress over the following described private road right-of-way (Kathy Lane): the North 30 feet of the South 185 feet of the West 400 feet of the East 425 feet of the North 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 2, Township 44 South, Range 42 East.
