The West 1/2 of Tract 14, Block "F", Loxahatchee Groves, as recorded in Plat Book 12, Page 29. Subject to an easement for drainage and utilities over the North 15.0 feet thereof. Subject to an easement over the South 20.0 feet for additional road right-of-way. Said property located on the northeast corner of the intersection of Okeechobee Boulevard (S.R.704) and "F" Road in an AR-Agricultural

Residential District was denied as advertised.
