

RESOLUTION NO. R-85-648

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 82-148(A), Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 82-148(A) was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on the 24th January 1985; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and the Zoning Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this the 24th of January 1985, that Petition No. 82-148(A) the petition of KIEHAN J. KILDAY, for the REZONING, FROM CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT on lots 1 and 2, Sunny Acres Suburban Homesites No. 2, as recorded in Plat Book 23, Page 198; together with the North 185 feet of the West 100 feet of the North 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4, in Section 24, Township 44 South, Range 42 East. Said property located on the southeast corner of the intersection of 10th Avenue North and Greene Drive was approved as advertised.
