RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION S86-4

Marcus, Chairman, to Revoke a Special Exception for a Planned Unit Development, on Palm Beach Farms Co., Plat 3, Tract 15 (Less south 150 feet, north 20 feet of west 316.42 feet and north 208.71 feet of south 358.61 feet of east 208.71 feet) Block 16, located approximately 0.2 of a mile south of Dillman Road and approxinately 3C3 feet west of Florida's Turnpike, was approved as advertised.
