RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION \$86-7
REVOKING A SPECIAL EXCEPTION FOR ZONING PETITION NO. 87-2
AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-82-414

Marcus, Chairman, to Revoke a Special Exception for a Planned Unit Development, on the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4, less the South 160 feet of the East 160 feet thereof; and the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4, less the South 160 feet thereof, and less the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 in Section 25, Township 43 South, Range 41 east, located approximately one-half mile west of State Road 7 and approximately 0.,6 of a mile south of Okeecnobee Road, was approved as advertised.
