## RESOLUTION NO. R-88 -134

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION S86-13
REVOKING A SPECIAL EXCEPTION FOR ZONING PETITION NO. 75-117
AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-75-695

WHEREAS, the Board of County Canmissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and Empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Petition No. S86-13 (Regarding Zoning Petition No. 75-117, Resolution No. R-75-695), The Petition of the Board of County Canmissioners, by Karen T. Marcus, Chairman, to Revoke a Special Exception for a Church and Private School, on the East 771.74 feet of the North 350 feet of the South 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 5, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, located on the north side of Summit Boulevard, approximately 500 feet east of Congress Avenue (State Road 807), was approved as advertised.
