## RESOLUTION NO. R-88-139

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION S86-25
REVOKING A SPECIAL EXCEPTION FOR ZONING PETITION NO. 78-223
AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-78-1282

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. S86-25 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at its public nearing conducted on November 18, 1986 and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Canmissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY CCMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Petition No. \$86-25 (Regarding Zoning Petition No. 78-223, Resolution No. R-78-1282), The Petition of the Board of County Canmissioners, by Karen T. Marcus, Chairman, to Revoke a Special Exception for a Recreational Vehicle Sales Lot and Repair Facility, on the West 200 feet of the South 425 feet of the East 1/2 of Tract 7, Block 9, Palm Beach Farms Canpany Plat No. 3, in Section 36, Township 43 South, Range 41 East, as recorded in Plat book 2, Page 46, except part taken for State Road No. 80, located on the north side of Southern Boulevard, approximately 600 feet west of State Road 7, was approved as advertised.
