RESOLUTION WITHDRAWING ZONING PETITION \$86-39

WHEREAS, the Board of County Canmissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and anpowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Petition No. S86-39 (Regarding Zoning Petition No. 75-83, Resolution No. R-82-720), The Petition of the Board of County Canmissioners, by Karen T. Marcus, Chairman, for the rezoning from CG-General Commercial Zoning District to RS-Single Family Residential Zoning District of Lots 20 through 26, inclusive, Military Park 3rd Nichols Addition, in Section 24, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 11, page 72; less the East 25 feet of Lots 24 and 25, and less the East 15 feet of Lot 26 on property located on at the southwest corner of Hibiscus Avenue and Military Trail, approximately 0.3 of a mile north of Okeechobee Boulevard, was withdrawn without prejudice.
