Marcus, Chairaan, for rezoning from CG-General Commercial Zoning District to RS-Single Family Residential Zoning District on the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4, the North 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 24, Towns'nip 43 South, Range 42 East, located on the West side of Military Trail, approximately 0.8 of a mile north of Okeechobee Boulevard, was withdrawn, without prejudice.
