RESOLUTION KITHDRAWING ZONING PETITION S86-41

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

whereas, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 462.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoniny Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. S86-41 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at its public hearing conducted on November 18, 1986; and

RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA that: Petition No. \$86-41 (regarding Zoning Petition No. \$2-125, Resolution No. R-83-196), the petition of the Board of County Commissioners, by Karen T. Marcus, Chairman, for the rezoning from CG-General Commercial Zoning District to KS-Single Family Residential Zoning District on the North 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4, lying South of Okeecnobee Road, being the Southerly 515 feet of the Northerly 590 feet of the Westerly 628.38 feet of the Easterly 1260.00 feet of Section 27, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, less, however the Easterly 60 feet of the Southerly 295 feet of the aforeuescribed parcel for dedicated Right-of-hay, located on the south side of Okeecnobee Road, approximately 0.1 of a mile east of Florida's Turnpike, was withdrawn, without prejudice
