## KESOLUTION WITHDRAWING ZONING PETITION \$86-42

WHEREAS, the Board of County Cannissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and enpowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. S86-42 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at its public hearing conducted on November 18, 1586 and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Cannissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and local land development regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALE BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA that: Petition No. \$86-42 (regarding Zoning Petition No. 80-225, Resolution No. R-81-45), the petition of the Board of County Commissioners, by Karen T. Marcus, Chairman, for the rezoning from IL-Light Industrial Zoning District to RS-Single Family Residential Zoning District on the East 1/2 of Tract 55, Block 5, PALM BEACH FARMS COMPANY PLANT NO. 3, in Section 34, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 46, located on the north side of Wallis Street (2nd Place North), approximately 600 feet west of Jog Road North, was withdrawn, without prejudice.

A motion to withdraw, without prejudice, Petition No. \$86-42 was offered by Canmissioner Ownes, who moved its adoption. The notion was seconded by Cannissioner Adams, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
